• Yasar Arafat (1929 - 2004) - Speaking to forty Arab diplomats at the Grand Hotel in Stockholm, 1/30/96:

"we will make life insufferable for the Jews by psychological warfare and population growth...within five years we will be 6-7 million Arabs in the West Bank and Jerusalem. If the Jews can import Ethiopians, Russians, Ukrainians and Uzbekians as Jews, we can import all kinds of Arabs...our program is to destroy the Jewish state and replace it with a pure Arab state. At least a million rich Jews will run away to America and take reparations..." (*Arab Goals and Methods*)

He called the genocidal Grand Mufti of Jerusalem, and friend of Hitler, Hajj Amin al-Husseini "our hero". (Geller)

He declared after the September 1972 massacre of eleven Israeli athletes at the Munich Olympic games that every Jew was a target and his subsequent proclamation that the

"end of Israel is the goal of our struggle, and it allows neither compromise nor mediation ... Peace for us means the destruction of Israel and nothing else,..." Laurent Murawiec, *The Mind of Jihad* (Cambridge: Cam- bridge University Press, 2008), pp. 34, 41. (*How Anti-Semitism Prevents Peace*, David Patterson)

In February 1979, just days after the Iranian Islamic revolution, Arafat was welcomed in Tehran where he declared to the founding fa- ther of the Islamic Republic, Ayatollah Ruhollah Khomeini:
